SummerFair, now in its 43rd year, is one of the most anticipated arts and crafts festivals in the region, featuring artisans from across the country. Artist booths at SummerFair include painting, pottery, art from nature, glass, wood, metal, fiber art, photography, body products, locally made products, and artisan foods. Visitors can enjoy all of this along with kids activities, local non-profits, food trucks, art demonstrations and more on MSU-Billings' lush campus.

NON-PROFIT BOOTH GUIDELINES

Your booth may display promotional material for your organization, memberships or other items to benefit your organization. All saleable products must be handmade, one of a kind, in order to comply with the mission of SummerFair. T-shirts are acceptable.

- All booth spaces are preassigned and specific spaces are not guaranteed. Non-profit booth preference will be given for organizations that are cultural partners.
- Due to the nature of this juried arts and crafts fair, all products for sale must be pre-approved by a museum representative.
- Each exhibitor is responsible for providing his/her own booth and equipment. SummerFair is outdoors. Exhibitors should plan for sun and/or inclement weather. All tents must be properly weighted.
- Only service animals will be allowed on the SummerFair site. No pets or emotional support animals on premises.
- Exhibitors will receive an ample amount of booth space (at least 10' x 10').
- 24-hour security is provided for MSU-B campus grounds, however we recommend all artists remove and safely store important items each night. The Yellowstone Art Museum is not responsible for any damage, theft, or accidents.
- Cancellation for any reason after June 2nd will result in forfeiture of booth fee.

SummerFair vendors are required to remain open through Sunday, June 27th until the closing time of 4:00 pm. Vehicles will not be allowed on the grounds from Friday at 2 pm until 4:15 pm on Sunday.
