NONPROFIT BOOTH GUIDELINES

Your booth may display promotional material for your organization, memberships or other items to benefit your organization. All saleable products must be original in order to comply with the mission of Summerfair. T-shirts are OK.

- **All booth spaces are preassigned and specific spaces are not guaranteed.**
- **Due to the nature of this juried arts and crafts fair, all products for sale must be pre-approved by a museum representative.**
- **Each exhibitor is responsible for providing his/her own booth and equipment.**
- **No pets allowed, only service animals will be permitted in the Summerfair site.**
- **Exhibitors will receive an ample amount of booth space (at least 10' x 10') .**
- **Security will be provided at the Metra, however we recommend all artists remove and safely store important items each night.**
- **Neither the Yellowstone Art Museum nor Metra Park are responsible for any damage, theft, or accidents.**
- **Cancellation for any reason after June 5th will result in forfeiture of booth fee.**
- **Summerfair vendors are required to remain open through Sunday, June 29th until the closing time of 3:00 pm.**
